

ZARAGOZA EXHIBITION CENTRE INFORMATION ON COVID-19

Zaragoza Exhibition Centre is in constant contact with the health authorities and the foreign affairs authorities regarding the coronavirus (Covid-19). At the present time the authorities do not see any need to restrict trade fair operations. Furthermore, currently there are no changes in the conditions of entry to Spain.

Zaragoza Exhibition Centre has put in place the recommendations and guidelines issued by the World Health Organisation (WHO) and by the health authorities with whom we are in permanent contact concerning events.

Zaragoza Exhibition Centre has recently celebrated FIMA, the International Agricultural Machinery Fair from 25th – 29th February, which received a great number of exhibitors and more than 200,000 visitors. This event took place following the recommendations of the health authorities and no incidents arose during the show.

Zaragoza Exhibition Centre has medical and health staff capable of responding to any contingency.

Zaragoza Exhibition Centre information offices will inform exhibitors and visitors where they can seek assistance in the event of any contingency.

Zaragoza Exhibition Centre has adopted the following measures for its events:

In coordination with the responsible cleaning services, we have increased the frequency of cleaning operations, particularly in toilets, bars and restaurants, etc.

Cleaning of areas with a heavy transit of people, such as entrances, door handles, lifts, corridors, conference areas, etc. has also been increased.

Additional hand sanitizer dispensers have been installed in toilets, bars, restaurants and at information points.

In view of the above, unless otherwise recommended by the authorities, SMOPYC will take place on the scheduled dates, from 1st – 4th April 2020, with the aforementioned precautionary measures in place.
